Diesel prices continue to decrease

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel fell to \$3.89 a gallon on Monday. That's down 1.1 cents from a week ago based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the West Coast states at 4.05 a gallon, down 5-tenths of a penny from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at 3.80 a gallon, down 8-tenths of a penny.
