U.S. gasoline price continues to increase (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose to \$1.96 a gallon on Monday. That's up 12 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at 2.39 a gallon, up 15 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at 1.75 a gallon, up 14.3 cents.
