U.S. gasoline price continues to decrease (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to \$2.29 a gallon on Monday. That's down 3.8 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at 2.76 a gallon, down 5-tenths of a penny from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at 2.07 a gallon, down 2.3 cents.
