Gasoline prices fall for first time this year (short version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell for the first time this year to \$3.76 a gallon on Monday. That's down 2 1/2 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.
