U.S. gasoline prices increase slightly (short version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose slightly to \$3.55 a gallon on Monday. That's up 2-tenths of a penny from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.
