## **U.S. gasoline prices continue to decrease (long version)**

---

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to \$3.27 a gallon on Monday. That's down 2.9 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast region at 3.56 a gallon, down 4 ½ cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast States at 3.03 a gallon, down 4.2 cents.
