Residential heating oil price decreases

The average retail price for home heating oil fell 1.9 cents from a week ago to \$2.80 per gallon. That's down \$1.44 from a year ago, based on the residential heating fuel survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration. Heating oil prices in the New England region fell to \$2.78 per gallon, down 1.2 cents from last week, and down \$1.40 from a year ago.
