Residential heating oil prices decrease

The average retail price for home heating oil fell 1.7 cents from a week ago to \$4.02 per gallon. That's up 1.7 cents from a year ago, based on the residential heating fuel survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration. Heating oil prices in the New England region fell to 4.01 per gallon, down 6-tenths of a cent from last week, and up 5.8 cents from a year ago.
