In accordance with the Clean Air Act (CAA), as amended (42 U.S.C. 7401 et seq.), the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has reviewed your application for a CAA Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) for Greenhouse Gas Emissions permit authorizing the construction of a new polyethylene unit at the existing facility.

The EPA issued and published requests for public comment regarding EPA's proposed action on the above application on July 17, 2013. During the public comment period, no comments were received for this proposed action. However, a few administrative and/or clarifying changes were included and a copy of the Final Permit Revision Summary is enclosed. After consideration of the pertinent Federal statutes, regulations, and additional material relevant to the application contained in our Administrative Record, the EPA hereby issues the enclosed PSD Permit for the facility described above.
