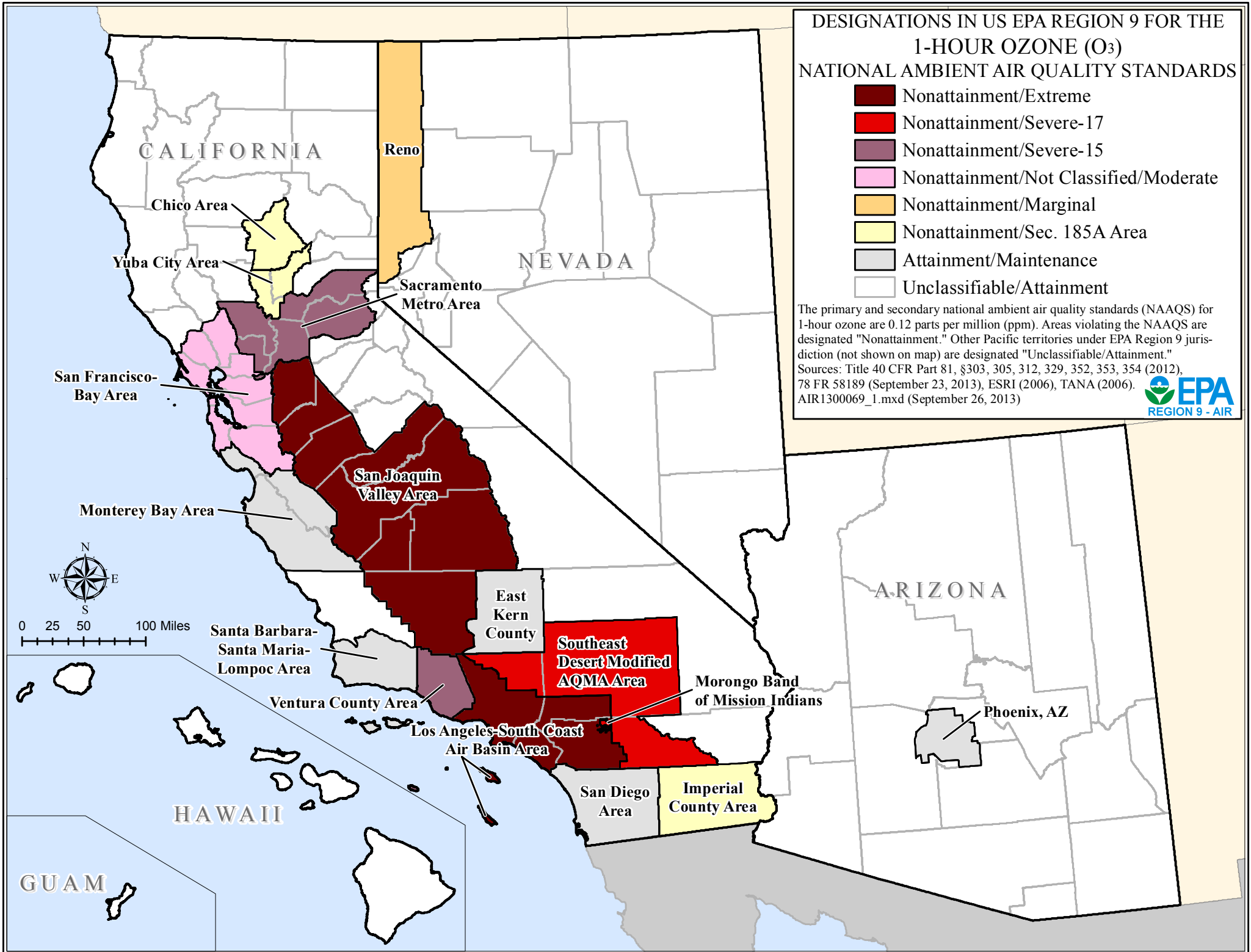


DESIGNATIONS IN US EPA REGION 9 FOR THE
1-HOUR OZONE (O₃)
NATIONAL AMBIENT AIR QUALITY STANDARDS

- Nonattainment/Extreme
- Nonattainment/Severe-17
- Nonattainment/Severe-15
- Nonattainment/Not Classified/Moderate
- Nonattainment/Marginal
- Nonattainment/Sec. 185A Area
- Attainment/Maintenance
- Unclassifiable/Attainment

The primary and secondary national ambient air quality standards (NAAQS) for 1-hour ozone are 0.12 parts per million (ppm). Areas violating the NAAQS are designated "Nonattainment." Other Pacific territories under EPA Region 9 jurisdiction (not shown on map) are designated "Unclassifiable/Attainment."
