



Emergency Watershed Protection Program McGrath Project

The Natural Resources Conservation Service in Alaska repaired a flood control levee along the Kuskokwim River in the off-road village of McGrath. The original levee was compromised by erosion, at one place only a foot wide, and the village was subject to flooding. Following levee repairs, the bank was stabilized with rock armor. The equipment had to be barged to the work site.

The Natural Resources Conservation Service funded this project with \$4,100,000.
