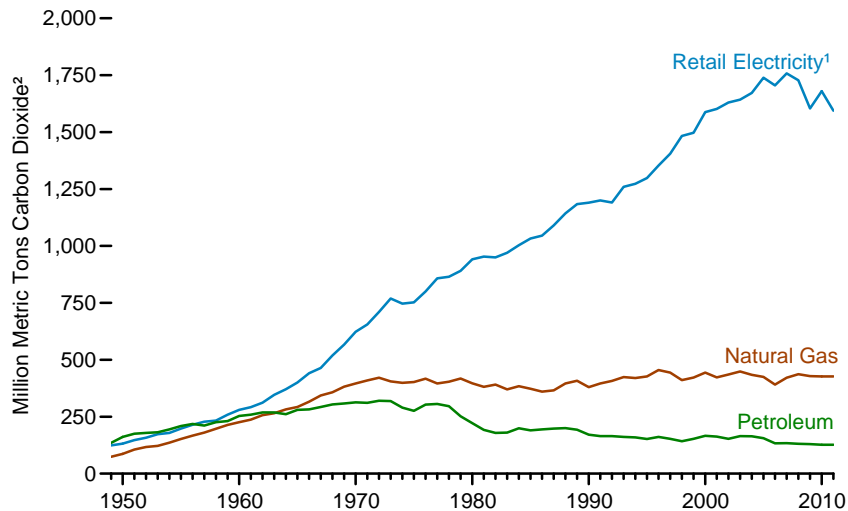
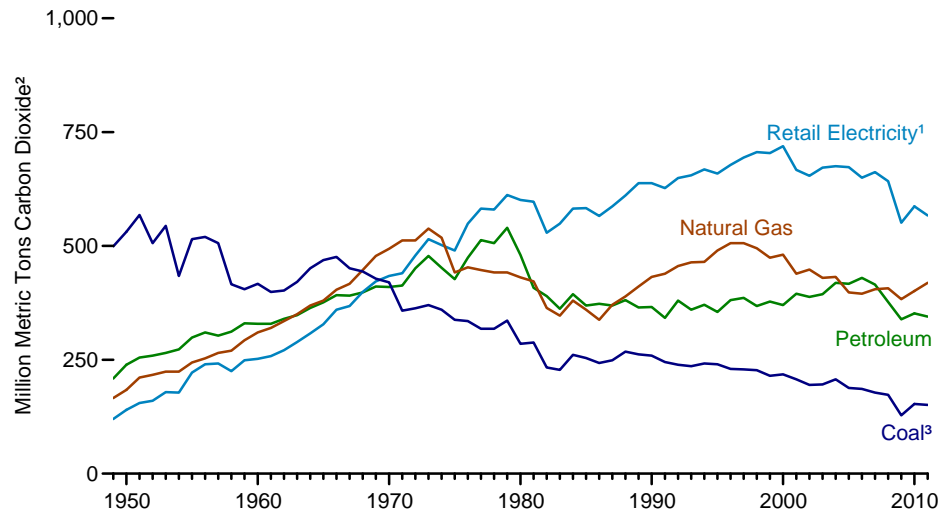


Figure 11.2 Carbon Dioxide Emissions From Energy Consumption by Sector, 1949-2011

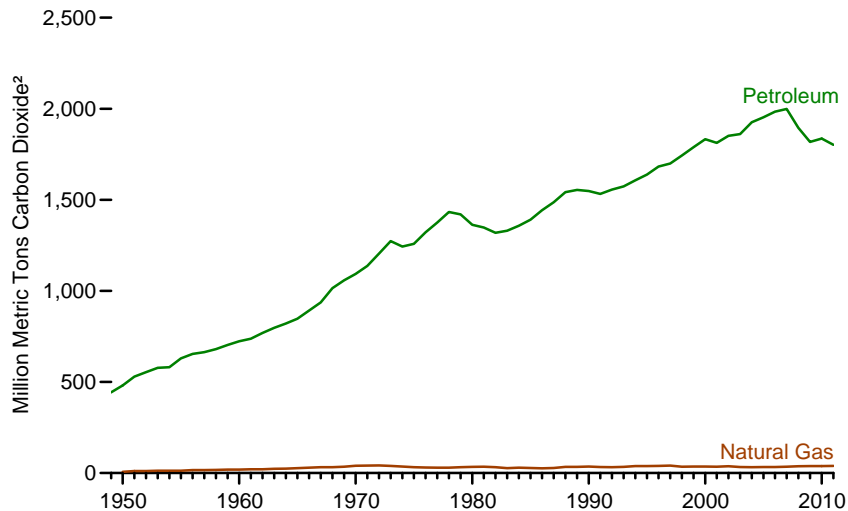
Residential and Commercial, by Major Source



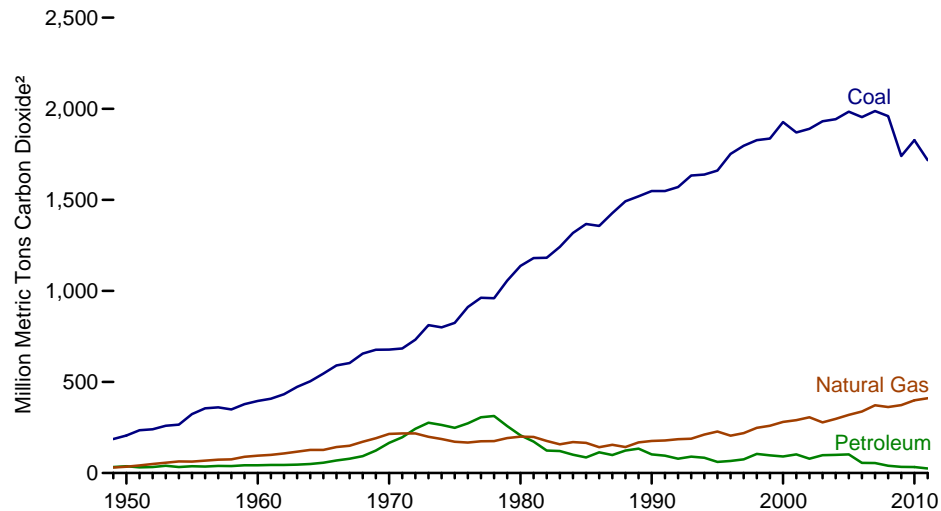
Industrial, by Major Source
