

# You can help protect marine mammals!

#### Admire from a distance

- Adhere to local guidelines or regulations for boating, fishing, and whale watching.
- Never approach whales within 100 feet, or right whales within 500 yards (1,500 feet).
- Support companies that commit to using best practices and protecting the oceans, such as whale watching companies that participate in Whale SENSE (www.whalesense.org)

## Report a crime

- It is illegal to harm, harass, or capture a marine mammal, to collect marine mammal parts, or attempt to do any of these things
- with limited exceptions.
- Report suspected violations to the NOAA Enforcement Hotline at 1-800-853-1964

#### Help sick animals

- Keep your distance and never attempt to touch or interact with animals on the beach.
- Report sick or injured animals to NOAA by calling 1-866-755-6622 so trained staff can respond to the situation.

### Be a good neighbor

- Recycle, reuse, dispose of garbage properly, and don't release balloons into the air. This will help prevent marine debris and keep the ocean clean and healthy.
- Tell your families and friends what they can do to help protect marine mammals!
