MOREHEAD CITY HARBOR, MAINTENANCE DREDGING

The Dredge McCaskill will commence dredging operations in portions of Ranges A and B near Fort Macon, North Carolina on or about March 15, 2014. The project will consist of dredging the waters within the Federal Navigation Channel. Dredged material will be placed by hydraulic pipeline on Atlantic Beach. The project is expected to continue until approximately April 30, 2014.

The Dredge will work twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week, and will give way to passing navigation. There are numerous support vessels and equipment that will be associated with this dredging operation, which include but not limited to tow vessels, tender boats, barges, derricks, and pipeline. The Dredge can be contacted on either VHF channel 13 or 16 for sailing instructions. Traffic should call 30 minutes prior to expected time of passage.
