A hazard to navigation exists in the Peletier Creek at Ranges A through C (authorized depth -6 ft.) near Morehead City, NC. Severe shoaling restricts the entire length and width of the Federal Channel in all three Ranges leading from the Atlantic Intracoastal Waterway to the Peletier Creek Basin. Conditions in Range A are shallower than -2.5 ft, in Range B are shallower than -4 ft, in Range C are shallower than -1 ft in the Federal Navigation Channel at Mean Low Water.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed and proceed with extreme caution.
