



**Memorandum of Understanding
Between
Petroleum & Natural Gas Regulatory Board (India)
And
Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (USA)**

In September 2011 Chairperson L. Mansingh, on behalf of the Petroleum & Natural Gas Regulatory Board of India, and Commissioner Philip Moeller, on behalf of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission of the United States, signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the intent that the two respective agencies would share regulatory experiences and practices. That agreement remained in effect until June 30, 2013. In October 2013 Chairperson S. Krishnan, on behalf of the PNGRB, and Commissioner Philip Moeller, on behalf of FERC, signed an extension of this Memorandum of Understanding to be in effect up to June 30, 2015.

In light of the positive and ongoing relationship between these two agencies, the Petroleum & Natural Gas Regulatory Board of India and the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission of the United States agree to enter into an addendum that would allow this Memorandum of Understanding to remain in effect up to June 30, 2017.
