# IMPORTS AND EXPORTS OF FISHERY PRODUCTS ANNUAL SUMMARY, 2014 REVISED

## IMPORTS

U.S. imports of edible fishery products in 2014 were valued at \$20.2 billion, up 12 percent from 2013. The quantity of edible imports was 2,523,120 metric tons, an increase of 22,214 tons (less than 1 percent) from the quantity imported in 2013.

The volume of shrimp imported in 2014 was 567,551 tons, an increase of 62,973 tons, or 12.5 percent, from the quantity imported in 2013. Shrimp Imports were valued at \$6.7 billion an increase of \$1.4 billion (26.9 percent) from 2012). Shrimp imports accounted for 33 percent of the value of total edible imports. Imports of fresh and frozen salmon were 301,280 tons valued at \$2.7 billion in 2014. Imports of fresh and frozen tuna were 166,272 tons, down 40,852 tons (19.7 percent) from 2013. The value of fresh and frozen tuna imports decreased by 11 percent to \$951 million. Imports of canned tuna were 155,193 tons, down 2,383 tons (12.4 percent) from 2013. The value of canned tuna imports also decreased dropping \$94.4 million (12.4 percent) from 2013. Imports of all fresh and frozen fillets and steaks amounted to 715,020 tons, an increase of 17,238 tons (less than 1 percent) from 2013. Total edible imports consisted of: 2,130,377 tons of fresh and frozen products valued at \$17.8 billion; 312,138 tons of canned products valued at \$1.9 billion; 41,103 tons of cured products valued at \$293.5 million; 2,776 tons of caviar and roe products valued at \$35.3 million; and 36,726 tons of other products valued at \$218.0 million.

Imports of nonedible fishery products were valued at \$15.6 billion, \$483.7 million (3.2 percent) more than in 2013. Total value of edible and nonedible fishery imports was \$35.9 billion in 2014, \$2.6 billion (7.9 percent) more than in 2013.

## EXPORTS

U.S. exports of edible fishery products of domestic origin in 2014 were 1,491,420 tons valued at \$5.3 billion, an increase of 36,047 tons (2.5 percent) and \$144.3 million (2.8 percent) over 2013.

Exports of fresh and frozen items were 1,373,885 tons valued at \$4.6 billion, an increase of 40,645 tons (3 percent) and an increase in value of \$216.7 million (5.0 percent) compared with 2013. Fresh and frozen exports consisted principally of 158,492 tons of salmon valued at \$581.2 million; 51,688 tons of lobster (*Homarus spp.*) valued at \$637.7 million; and 178,493 tons of surimi valued at \$411.8 million. Exported canned items totaled 57,397 tons valued at \$301.3 million. Salmon was the major canned item exported, with 42,606 tons valued at \$206.3 million. Cured items accounted for 4,989 tons of exports valued at \$19.7 million. Caviar and roe exports were 43,672 tons valued at \$395.5 million. Other edible products accounted for 11,447 tons valued at \$59.7 million.

Exports of nonedible products were valued at \$17.9 billion. Exports of fish meal amounted to 196,171 tons valued at \$160.7 million. The total value of edible and nonedible exports was \$23.2 billion, \$279.5 million more than in 2013.

## RE-EXPORTS

U.S. exports of edible fishery products of foreign origin in 2014 were 51,653 tons valued at \$410.9 million, a decrease of 635 tons (1.2 percent) and an increase of \$24.6 million (6.4 percent) from 2013.

Fresh and frozen items were 46,823 tons valued at \$371.5 million. This reflects a decrease of 312 tons and an increase of \$27.8 million compared with 2013. Shrimp (3,017 tons valued at \$39.6 million), salmon (12,577 tons valued at \$105.9 million), crabs (1,738 tons valued at \$26.9 million) and tuna (1,227 tons valued at \$6.0 million) were the principle fresh and frozen products re-exported. Canned items accounted for 2,526 tons valued at 10.5 million. Cured products were 295 tons valued at \$3.0 million. Caviar and roe re-exports were 638 tons valued at \$15.1 million. Other edible products were 1,371 tons valued at \$10.9 million.

Re-exports of nonedible fishery products were valued at \$5.8 billion. Fish oils accounted for 2,592 tons valued at \$17.9 million. The total value of edible and nonedible re-exports was \$6.8 billion, \$574.0 million more than in 2013.

## NOTES:

Unless otherwise noted, the information presented is based on U.S. Census Bureau data for the Customs territory of the United States. The territory includes the 50 states, District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands.

Imports for consumption are a combination of entries into the U.S. for immediate consumption and withdrawals from Customs bonded warehouses for consumption. These data reflect the actual entry into U.S. consumption channels of commodities that originated outside the United States.

Exports may include merchandise of both domestic and foreign origin. Census defines exports of “domestic” merchandise to include commodities, which are grown, produced, or manufactured in the United States. For statistical purposes, domestic exports also include commodities of foreign origin which have been changed in the U.S. from the form in which they were imported, or which have been enhanced in value by further manufacture in the United States.

Re-exports of “foreign” products are commodities which have entered the U.S. as imports and not sold, which, at the time of re-export, are in substantially the same condition as when imported. Items imported for sale in the U.S. but later resold overseas, however, are recorded as exports of domestic goods rather than as re-exports.

A product of foreign origin is transformed into a domestic good when the imported item loses its foreign identity through further substantial manufacturing. This transformation generally produces a good with a different trade classification. For example, fish sticks cut from imported fish blocks, when exported to a foreign country, are classified as domestic for statistical purposes.

The value of imports presented is the “Customs value.” It is based on the value of the product in the country of origin as appraised by the U.S. Customs and Border Protection, and excludes import duties, freight, insurance, and other charges incurred in bringing it to the United States. Export and re-export value is equivalent to f.a.s. (free alongside ship) at the port of export, based on the transaction price, including freight, insurance, and other charges incurred in placing the merchandise alongside the carrier. The value excludes the cost of loading, freight and subsequent insurance.
