## TATTOO GUIDELINES

**MARINE CORPS BULLETIN 1020** 

Not seen when wearing an undershirt, and below the seventh vertebrae — Not seen above the collar bone

—— At least 2 inches above the elbow

At least 1 inch below the elbow -

At least 2 inches above the wrist

At least 2 inches above and below the knee

\*All Marines may have unlimited tattoos on any area of the body that is covered by the properly fitting standard PT Uniform \*\*Officers are limited to no more than four visible in the standard PT uniform

## **Tattoo Placement**

Head or Neck: Not Authorized
Hands, Fingers, and Wrists: Not Authorized\*\*\*
Upper Arms: At least 2 inches above the elbow
Lower Arms: At least 1 inch below elbow / 2 inches above the wrist
Upper Legs: At least 2 inches above the knee
Lower Legs: At least 2 inches below the knee

## **Tattoo Content**

Bands: No greater than 3 inches visible or the width of the individual Marine's four fingers extended and joined, whichever is greater
\*\*\*Wedding Band Tattoos: No more than 3/8 inches on one finger
Single Tattoos: Authorized when completely covered by your hand with your fingers extended and joined with the thumb flush against the side of the hand
Collection of Tattoos: Authorized when completely covered by your hand with your fingers extended extended and joined with the thumb flush against the side of the hand
