U.S. diesel prices increase for first time since late April

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel rose for the first time in 8 weeks to \$3.92 a gallon on Monday. That's up 3.7 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the New England region at 4.10 a gallon, up 1.4 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at 3.81 a gallon, up 4.3 cents.
