U.S. diesel prices continue to decrease

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel fell to \$3.89 a gallon on Monday. That's down 1.9 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the New England region at 4.08 a gallon, down 2 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at 3.79 a gallon, down a penny and a half.
