Gasoline price shows small increase (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline showed little movement from last week. Prices rose 4/10 of a cent to \$3.30 a gallon on Monday, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the New England States, at 3.52 a gallon, down 1/10 of a penny from a week ago. Prices were lowest at 2.87 a gallon in the Rocky Mountain States, with the biggest regional price drop at close to 7 cents.
