Gasoline prices show sharp increase (short version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline saw its sharpest increase this year at \$3.54 a gallon on Monday. That's up 18.1 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.
