Gasoline prices up this week (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose to \$3.61 a gallon on Monday. That's up 7.3 cents from a week ago and up 25.4 cents from two weeks ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast region at 3.87 a gallon, up almost 13 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Rocky Mountain States at 3.27 a gallon, up 13 cents.
