U.S. gasoline prices continue to increase (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose to \$2.77 a gallon on Memorial Day Monday. That's up 3 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at 3.49 a gallon, down 2.6 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at 2.49 a gallon, up 2 cents.
