U.S. gasoline prices fall to lowest level since December 2010 (short version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to its lowest level since December 2010 at \$3.06 a gallon on Monday. That's down 6.4 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.
