Gasoline prices continue to decrease (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to \$3.67 a gallon on Monday. That's down 1.6 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at 4.02 a gallon, down 3.3 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at 3.44 a gallon, down 2.8 cents.
