Residential heating oil price increases

The average retail price for home heating oil rose one cent from a week ago to \$2.64 per gallon. That's up 47.8 cents from a year ago, based on the residential heating fuel survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration. Heating oil prices in the New England region rose to \$2.60 per gallon, up 1.2 cents from last week, and up 49.3 cents from a year ago.
