Residential heating oil price decreases

The average retail price for home heating oil fell 2.9 cents from a week ago to \$3.45 per gallon. That's down 36.6 cents from a year ago, based on the residential heating fuel survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration. Heating oil prices in the New England region fell to \$3.41 per gallon, down 3 cents from last week, and down 35 cents from a year ago.
