Mr. Barron currently serves as the Director for Assured Command and Control (N2N6F1) within the Directorate of the Deputy Chief of Naval Operations (DCNO) Information Warfare (N2/N6). As N2N6F1, Mr. Barron is responsible for oversight, resource sponsorship, spectrum management, and the cybersecurity of Navy tactical, operational, and enterprise communications, networks, and command and control systems.

From July 2010 to February 2016 Mr. Barron served as Director for Aircraft Carrier Design and Systems Engineering within Naval Sea System Command Naval Systems Engineering Directorate (SEA 05) providing technical leadership to ensure current and future aircraft carriers perform mission requirements.

From July 2008 to July 2010, Mr. Barron served as the Senior Ship Design Manager for the Next Generation Cruiser (CGX), implementing platform level Technical Authority, and providing ship design, and technical expertise to the (CGX) Program Office.

From November 2006 to July 2008 he served as Chief Systems Engineer for Integrated Mission Systems in Naval Sea Systems Command SEA 05, implementing Technical Authority for Surface Combatant Warfare Systems.

From October 2002 to November 2006, he served as an Executive Director for ManTech International Corporation.

Captain Barron retired from the U.S. Navy in October 2002, having served as Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Navy for Mines and Undersea Warfare, supporting the Assistant Secretary of the Navy for Research Development and Acquisition. He also served as the Major Program Manager for Submarine Warfare Systems (PMS 401).

Captain Barron served as Commanding Officer, *USS Memphis* (*SSN 691*) from 1996 to 1998. During his tour, the ship completed a Refueling Overhaul, post overhaul certifications, and a successful six month deployment to the Mediterranean Sea. Other at-sea commands included *USS Topeka* (*SSN 754*) as Executive Officer, *USS Drum* (*SSN 677*) as Engineer Officer, and *USS William H. Bates* (*SSN 680*) as division officer. Captain Barron's shore tours include Force Nuclear Power Officer on the Staff of Commander Submarine Force, U.S. Pacific Fleet, Commander In Chief Atlantic Fleet, Nuclear Propulsion Examining Board, and Maintenance Officer at Nuclear Power Training Unit S1C.

Mr. Barron earned a bachelor's of science degree in Electrical Engineering from the U.S. Naval Academy and served as Co-Captain of the Varsity Track Team.
