Mr. Hogg assumed his duties as Director of the Program/Budget Coordination Division on 30 June, 2014. He is responsible for implementing overall budget strategies; promulgating budget formulation guidance; developing Navy, Marine Corps, and Secretariat procedures for the Departmental resource decision-making process; monitoring and continuously evaluating budget execution performance; processing fund allocations for the entire Department of the Navy; establishing budget controls; and development and operation of IT systems in support of the budget process.

Mr. Hogg entered the Senior Executive Service in December 2011 with his initial assignment as the Deputy Director, Program and Financial Control, Office of the Under Secretary of Defense (Comptroller). Mr. Hogg assured the timely processing and control of program budget decisions and oversaw data base reconciliations to remain within the Department of Defense's funding limits. Mr. Hogg previously served as the Deputy Director for the Program/Budget Coordination Division within the Department of the Navy's Office of Budget from June 2005 to December 2011. In this position, he was responsible for coordinating the overall appraisal of the Department of the Navy's budget and budget process to ensure the development of a cohesive and balanced program.

He retired from active duty as a Captain in June 2005, following a 24-year career as a Naval Aviator, where he amassed over 4,000 flight hours in helicopters and 1,800 shipboard landings. While on active duty, Mr. Hogg served in assignments both afloat and ashore. His operational tours included service as the Flight Deck Officer in USS NASSAU (LHA 4), multiple tours as a SH-60B LAMPS helicopter pilot, Detachment Officer-in-Charge in USS DEYO (DD-989) and in USS SIMPSON (FFG-56), and Executive Officer / Commanding Officer of the "Grandmasters" of HSL-46. Under his command the Grandmasters were selected as the 1999 Commander Naval Air Forces Atlantic Fleet Battle Efficiency Winner's, they also earned the Commander Helicopter Anti-Submarine Light Wing Atlantic Fleet Maintenance Excellence Award for 1999. Ashore, he served in a variety of flying and financial management positions, including Instructor Pilot, Squadron Maintenance Officer, Budget Analyst for the Naval Air Warfare Division, Maritime Warfare Branch Head for the Surface Warfare Division, the Office

of Budget where he served as the Deputy Director of the Investment and Development Division, and then his final military assignment as the Assistant Director, for the Navy Budget Office.

Mr. Hogg graduated from the U.S. Naval Academy in 1981 with a Bachelor of Science degree in History. He holds a Master's degree in National Security and Strategic Studies from the Naval War College in Newport, Rhode Island. Mr. Hogg has received various personal military awards, including the Legion of Merit, the Meritorious Civilian Service Medal, the Meritorious Service Medal with two gold stars, and the Single Action Air Medal.
