Mr. Lasher serves as the Deputy Director for Program Integration (N2/N6FP) for the Deputy Chief of Naval Operations for Information Dominance (DCNO N2/N6). The mission of N2/N6FP is to integrate Communications, Networks, Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance (ISR), Oceanography, Space, Cyber, Electronic Warfare and Command and Control investments and prioritize related warfighting and intelligence requirements for more than 180 programs totaling \$56 billion across the Future Years Defense Plan (FYDP).

Mr. Lasher entered the executive service in December 2012 having previously served on the OPNAV N2/N6 staff as the Program and Budget Integration Branch Head. In this position he was responsible for the development and defense of the N2/N6 portion of the annual Navy Program Objective Memorandum. He also coordinated the integration of the N2, N6, and selected N8 programs associated with the OPNAV re-organization in October 2009. Prior to entering the civil service in May 2008 he supported OPNAV N6 as a contractor.
