Director, Warfare Integration Division Chief of Naval Operations (N9I)



Mr. Lluy assumed his current position as Director, Warfare Integration Division (N9I) on the staff of the Chief of Naval Operations (OPNAV) in January, 2016. As the Director he is responsible for assessing the relative warfighting systems' investment priorities and integrates Deputy, Chief of Naval Operations, Warfare Systems (N9) research and development, procurement, readiness and manpower portfolios totaling \$90B annually in support of the Chief of Naval Operations annual Program Objective Memorandum (POM) proposal to the Secretary of the Navy. In addition, he and his staff supervise and resource the Navy's in-service ship disposition process and develops the Navy's Long-Range Shipbuilding Plan supporting ship procurement over the next 30 years.

Previously, Mr. Lluy served as Deputy, Director Air Warfare Division (N98B) from August 2013 to January 2016. In this capacity, he was responsible for the division's programming and budgeting, portfolio management, plans and studies, and internal business processes. Specifically, he oversaw all N98 budgeting and programming activities relating to naval aviation investment, readiness and manpower accounts, including development of the aviation budget submission. Additionally, Mr. Lluy served as the Deputy Budget Director at the Department of Energy (DOE) from June 2012 to August 2013. In this capacity, he led a budget division responsible for a wide-range of financial duties including independent analytical support to the Secretary of Energy on budget formulation and execution matters, internal coordination and integration of the annual DOE budget submission and final roll-out of the Department's annual budget request to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB).

Prior to joining the Senior Executive Service, Mr. Lluy had a distinguished 27-year career as a commissioned officer and naval aviator in the United States Navy where he served in a variety of operational and staff assignments. From 2008-2011 he served as Branch Director and later, acting Deputy Director of the Warfare Integration and Programming Division (OPNAV N8F) where he was responsible for the development and coordination of the Navy's annual integrated investment program proposal totaling over \$60 billion dollars annually. His operational assignments included multiple flying tours in various Navy rotary-wing squadrons culminating in command of the Navy's largest aviation wing from 2006-2008.

Mr. Lluy earned a Bachelor of Science degree from the United States Naval Academy, and a Master of Arts in National Security Affairs from the Naval Postgraduate School. He has received numerous awards throughout his career including the Legion of Merit and Bronze Star medals.
