Jane P. McMullen serves as Assistant Commander for Corporate Operations (N1N5) and was selected for the Senior Executive Service in December 2015. She previously served as DLA Distribution Director, Organizational Management/J9 Expeditionary Logistics.

McMullen is a graduate of West Virginia University with a bachelor's degree in statistics and holds a master's degree in public administration from Penn State University. Additionally, she is a graduate of the Joint Forces Staff College, the Naval Supply Systems Command (NAVSUP) Corporate Management Development Program, and was a member of the Defense Leadership and Management Program.

McMullen began her federal civil service career in 1980 as a mathematician in the Operations Analysis Department, Navy Fleet Material Support Office, Mechanicsburg, Pa. She has held numerous positions during her early Navy career including operations research analyst; assistant to the Ship's Parts Control Center (SPCC) Executive Director; SPCC Re-systemization training coordinator; and Platform Manager for the U.S. Coast Guard, Military Sealift Command TAGS-60 Class and the Navy AOE-6 Class.

Joining NAVSUP in 1995, she served as a pricing analyst for the Deputy Commander for Financial Management/Comptroller; and Deputy Director, Food Service Division, for the Deputy Commander for Support Services, where she was responsible for providing policy oversight and guidance to approximately 400 enlisted dining facilities (ashore and afloat), 9,000 food service personnel, and a \$300 million budget for the feeding of over 325,000 Navy personnel daily.

In December 2005, McMullen was selected as Director of the Enterprise Planning Division in NAVSUP's Corporate Operations. Previously, she served as Director of the Strategic Business Division and Director of the Human Capital Management Division, both located in NAVSUP's Corporate Operations Directorate.
