As Director of the Resource Management Division within OPNAV N1, and Bureau of Naval Personnel Comptroller, Mr. Parel is responsible for the programming, budgeting, execution, and accounting of approximately \$32 billion of Department of the Navy resources annually. He was responsible for all Marine Corps Military Personnel, Operations and Maintenance, Military Construction/Family Housing, Working Capital fund, and Acquisition programs and accounts. Mr. Parel was highly involved in the 2010 Statement of Budgetary Resources audit. From 2011 until 2016, Mr. Parel served as the Associate Director of Investment in the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense (Comptroller), where he oversaw manned/unmanned aircraft, space, nuclear, cyber, weapons, military/national intelligence programs, Overseas Contingency Operations investments, the Joint Improvised-Threat Defeat Fund, and was the co-chair of the Joint Rapid Acquisition Cell supporting the Secretary's Warfighter-Senior Integration Group.
