P.L. 94 Redi Census 2000 (P.L. 94 Redistricting Data Pengre of Day Jummary file To get the first information from Census 2000—total population, population by race and Hispanic or Latino origin, and voting age population—look for the Redistricting Summary (Public Law 94-171) File. This file is produced primarily for states to redraw the boundaries of their various congressional and legislative districts. Tabulations from this file, which are available for areas as small as city blocks, are also useful for planning and analysis in both the government and business sectors.

## American FactFinder

Data are available on the Internet through the American FactFinder® (AFF). If you need just a few numbers, visit us on the Internet at www.census.gov, and click on American FactFinder®.

- Start with Basic Facts and choose the table, the level of geography, and the state you want.
- Click on Local Census 2000 Results Now Available under Items of Interest and click on the state you need. Then click on Change Selections to bring up a different table, a different geographic area, or to change data sets.
- Click on Data Sets to access all the available statistics in the Redistricting release
- Click on Geographic Comparison Tables or Quick Tables in FactFinder Data Sources for quick looks and comparisons in preformatted tables.

Experienced users may want to download **files.** Users can download data through the file transfer protocol (FTP) for a specific state.

Please note that through this method users will be able to download whole state

data files. Users may also download specific tables generated from AFF in either spreadsheet or text

format. To download complete state files, click on Data Sets on the American FactFinder® page and then Data Sets available for FTP. in the lower left-hand area of the page. Or, from the Census Bureau home page, click on Access Tools and then Census 2000 Data Sets under Direct File Access. Note that these files are available in ASCII comma-

delimited format, and do not come with viewing software. Given the size of the files, the speed of your modem and Internet connection, downloading a file may be a timeconsuming process.

Use CD-ROM or DVD for large-scale analyses. If you plan to analyze data for more than a few areas, consider purchasing the Public Law 94-171 data on CD-ROM or DVD. Data are released on a state-by-state basis on CD-ROM, with most states fitting onto a single disc. Once all states are available, the files are also released on DVD. Use the form on the last page to order the states you need. Or, order online through the Catalog link on the Census Bureau's home page.

Files on the CD-ROMs and DVDs are in both database (.DBF) and ASCII, comma-delimited format, and come with viewing software.

**New race data available.** The Redistricting Summary File contains the following items:

- Total population and population by 63 race categories.
- Hispanic or Latino population and the population not Hispanic or Latino by 63 race categories.



- Population 18 and over by 63 race categories.
- Hispanic or Latino population 18 years and over and the population not Hispanic or Latino 18 years and over by 63 race categories.

The very detailed race categories are the result of a change in federal guidelines for collecting and presenting race data. These categories include:

- White alone
- Black or African American alone
- American Indian and Alaska Native alone
- Asian alone
- Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander alone
- Some other race alone...

...as well as the total possible combinations of these groups.

**Each state file presents data down to the block level**. Data are released on a state-by-state basis. The following levels of geography are included on each state disc.

For users who may only need data for cities, counties and states, a special CD-ROM, entitled Race and Hispanic or Latino Summary File, will be available on a single CD-ROM.

These population figures do not reflect adjustment for coverage errors in Census 2000 as measured by the Accuracy and Coverage Evaluation.

You Need to Map Things Out. You'll need a map to find out the location and boundaries of the geographic areas available in the Redistricting Summary File. Official Census 2000 PL-94-171 map products are available electronically through the Internet, on DVD and on paper.
