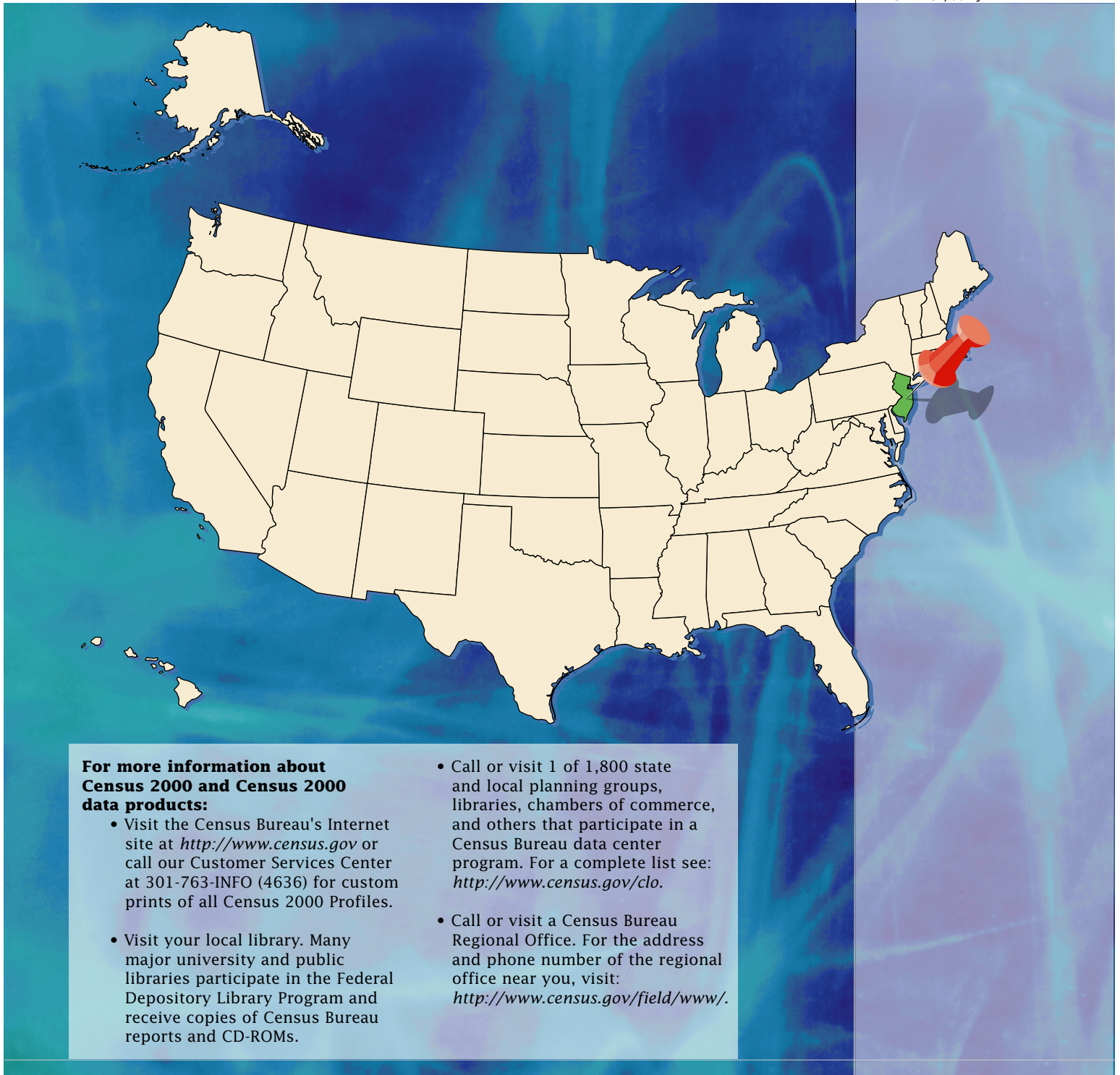

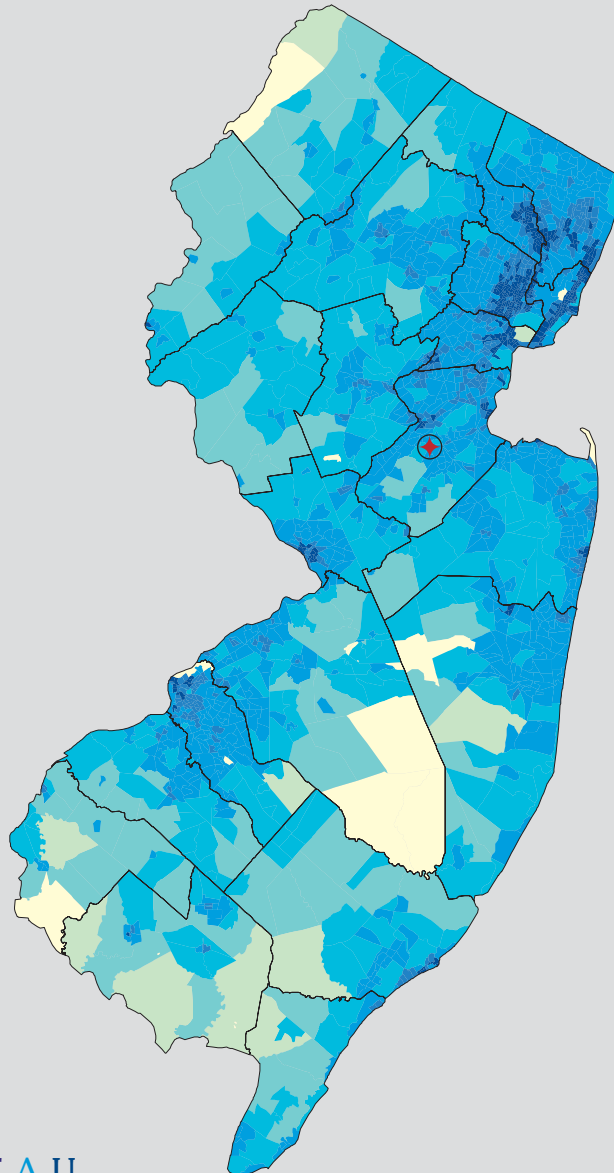

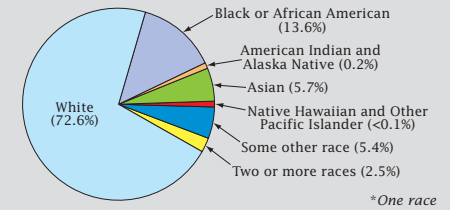

## Population Density by Census Tract

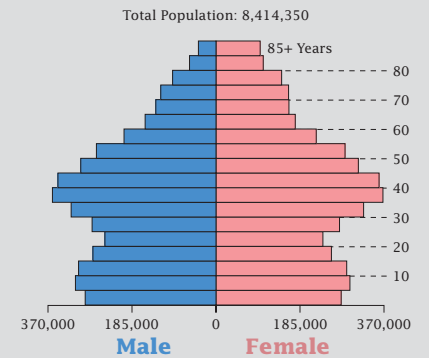

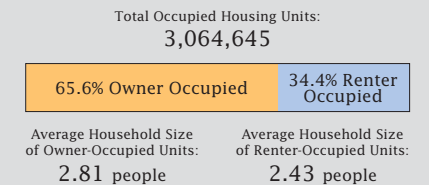


Hispanic or Latino (of any race) makes up **13.3%** of the state population.

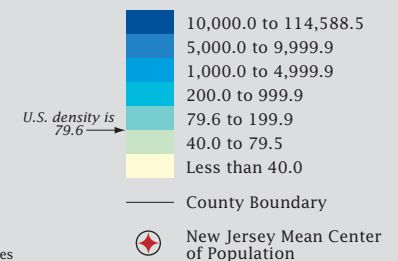
## Population by Sex and Age
