     and all in caps. For example, "You may submit your comments and
     materials concerning this proposed rule by one of the methods listed in the
     ADDRESSES section."
- Italicize the following:
  - URLs (web site addresses) http://www.fws.gov
  - e-mail addresses *John\_Doe@fws.gov*
  - scientific names *Salvelinus confluentus* (and *Astragalus lentiginosus* var. *coachellae*)
  - parties in court cases (but not the v.) Defenders of Wildlife v.
    Norton
  - *et seq.* (Note that *GPO Style Manual* does not italicize this, but internal OFR style does italicize this.)
  - *et al.* (Note that *GPO Style Manual* does not italicize this, but internal OFR style does italicize this.)
- Do not italicize:
