November 2015 Monthly Report

No fish were stocked this month.

70 visitors signed the guest registration.

All razorback suckers that are scheduled to be stocked in January 2016 were tagged this month. Bureau of Reclamation, Park Service and NDOW all assisted in the PIT tag effort of 7,000 RBS greater than 300mm.



A pre-bid meeting was held for the upcoming road and parking area renovation. Eight contracting companies participated in the meeting and walk through.

Mark Olson and Jae Ahn participated in a conference call with the U.S. Department of Transportation, Central Federal Lands Highway Division. The purpose of the call was to verify and record road conditions, record information about parking areas and report deficient transportation features on the hatchery grounds.

Maintenance Activities

A concrete retaining wall and sidewalk were poured; more rock debris was removed from behind shop building; batteries on the distribution truck were replaced; the 5 bay garages were cleaned and some items were made available for excess.
