Bonytail fry were shipped from Southwestern Native Aquatic Resources and Recovery Center. These fish will be grown at WB for a month then transferred to ponds at Achii.



Mark Olson traveled with BR to Planet Ranch. This location is a remote ranch that BR purchased under the LCRMSCP program. The ranch will be used for conservation wetland and endangered fish production. There is a possibility that FWS will be operating the fish production program so BR asked for input on the planning and construction of those facilities.

BR and NDOW collected razorbacks from the hatchery reared to 3 inches by WB staff. Annually WB rears surplus fish for NDOW until they can bring their early rearing capacity up to fill their needs.

The Parking Lot Rehabilitation was completed. In addition, the contractor seal coated the entire newly installed road due to aggregate separation. This filled in the voids on the surface and in theory extends the life of the road.
