Species Covered	Northern spotted owl
Background	Two northern spotted owl sites are affected. The city of The Dalles will adopt federal matrix standards and guides.
Benefits	This HCP establishes a cooperative relationship whereby the Fish and Wildlife Service and the Mt. Hood National Forest will work together, using applicable federal standards, to manage spotted owl habitat so as to maintain the health of the watershed and protect the source of The Dalles' drinking water.
