<b>Location</b>	Coos and Douglas counties
<b>Acreage</b>	208,000 acres
<b>Species Covered</b>	Northern spotted owl
<b>Background</b>	This HCP provides protection for existing spotted owl nest sites while allowing for the harvest of trees within the owls' home range. Approximately 17,000 acres may be harvested within nesting habitat, however, a greater acreage will be maintained in dispersal habitat.
<b>Benefits</b>	Existing nest sites will be protected and the landscape will support dispersal of spotted owls over a large area.
