

1970—Peregrine falcon added to the Endangered Species List Recovery teams develop regional recovery plans

Recovery actions implemented, including:

Protect/enhance habitat, Minimize disturbance/mortality, Monitor contaminants (DDT), Reintroduce captive-bred birds

Recovery objectives achieved including number of breeding pairs

June 30, 1995—Service publishes notice of intent to propose delisting of the peregrine falcon

August 26, 1998—Service proposes to remove peregrine falcon from Endangered Species List

Service receives and evaluates comments on proposal

August 25, 1999—Service removes peregrine falcon from Endangered Species List

2003—Service and partners implement monitoring plan for first year.

2006—Monitoring results from 2003 released.

Population is up; breeding indicators

are strong.

2006—Second monitoring year begins.
