AMENDMENT 1 TO THE NORTHEAST COASTAL COMMUNITIES SECTOR OPERATIONS PLAN

APPROVED BY THE NATIONAL MARINE FISHERIES SERVICE APRIL 26, 2011

EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 2011, THROUGH APRIL 30, 2012 - THE 2011 FISHING YEAR

This amendment officially recognizes the FY 2011 exemptions approved for the Northeast Coastal Communities Sector:

- 1. 120-Day Block Requirement Out of the Fishery for Day Gillnet Vessels
- 2. 20-Day Spawning Block
- 3. Limitation on the Number of Hooks that May be Fished
- 4. Submission of Daily Catch Reports by Sector Managers for Vessels that Fish in the Closed Area I Hook Gear Haddock Special Access Program
- 5. Vessel Monitoring System Requirements when a Vessel is at the Dock
- 6. Dockside Monitoring (DSM) Requirements for Handgear A-permitted Sector Vessels
- 7. DSM Requirements for Vessels Fishing on Both a Monkfish and Multispecies Days-at-Sea in the Southern Fishery Management Area (SFMA) using 10-inch or Greater Mesh
