## AMENDMENT 1 TO THE PORT CLYDE COMMUNITY GROUNDFISH SECTOR OPERATIONS PLAN

APPROVED BY THE NATIONAL MARINE FISHERIES SERVICE APRIL 26, 2011 EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 2011, THROUGH APRIL 30, 2012 - THE 2011 FISHING YEAR

This amendment officially recognizes the FY 2011 exemptions approved for the Port Clyde Community Groundfish Sector:

- 1. 120-Day Block Requirement Out of the Fishery for Day Gillnet Vessels
- 2. Prohibition on a Vessel Hauling Another Vessel's Gillnet Gear
- 3. Limitation on the Number of Gillnets for Day Gillnet Vessels
- 4. 20-Day Spawning Block
- 5. Limitation on the Number of Hooks that May be Fished
- 6. Length and Horsepower Restrictions of the Days-at-Sea Leasing Program
- 7. Gulf of Maine Sink Gillnet Mesh Exemption
- 8. Vessel Monitoring System Requirements when a Vessel is at the Dock
