U.S. diesel fuel price continues to increase

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel rose to \$2.94 a gallon on Monday. That's up 3.6 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest at 3.29 a gallon in the New England region, up 11.8 cents from a week ago and in the Central Atlantic region, up 13.3 cents. Prices were lowest in the Rocky Mountain states at 2.78 a gallon, up 1.7 cents.
