U.S. diesel fuel prices continue to increase

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel rose to \$2.20 a gallon on Monday. That's up 3.3 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the West Coast states at 2.41 a gallon, up 3 ½ cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at 2.07 a gallon, up 2.8 cents.
