U.S. diesel fuel prices increase for first time since June

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel rose for the first time since June to \$2.37 a gallon on Monday. That's up 6 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration. Diesel prices were highest in the West Coast states at 2.62 a gallon, up 4 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at 2.25 a gallon, up 7 cents.
