U.S. diesel fuel price continues to decrease

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel fell to \$3.21 a gallon on Monday. That's down 6.8 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the New England region at 3.37 a gallon, down 6 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at 3.12 a gallon, down 5.4 cents.
