Diesel prices decrease for first time in seven weeks

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel fell for the first time in seven weeks to \$4.13 a gallon on Monday. That's down 2.9 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the New England region at 4.30 a gallon, down 4.6 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Rocky Mountain States at 4.05 a gallon, down a penny.
