U.S. gasoline prices increase for first time in 8 weeks (short version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose to \$1.73 a gallon on Monday. That's up 6-tenths of a penny from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.
